This Lesson on the Ten Commandments will give children a great example of how to love others. What is the point of not cheating? Not lying? Not stealing? Is it all to keep God from getting angry? No. It's actually about God's love. God hates heartache, and these are the base rules that teach us not to cause heartache for others AND for God, who feels the same emotions that we feel, only to a greater extent.

EXCERPTS FROM EXCERPTS FROM EXODUS

Read the following excerpts as shown (NIV translation), or read from your chosen Bible translation:



EXODUS 20:1-17

¹ And God spoke all these words:

- ² "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.
 ³ "You shall have no other gods before me.
- ⁴ "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.

⁵ You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me,

⁶ but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

⁷ "You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

⁸ "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

¹⁰ but the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns.

Questions for Children about the 10 Commandments

1. God's first commands were about loving him. Just think: If your mom and dad decided they loved some other child more than you and gave you away, how hurt would you be? *Hurt, angry, confused, and more hurt.* So, how would God feel if we decided we loved an idol more than him? *Hurt, angry, and more hurt.*

2. "Giving false testimony" is a very hurtful type of lie. It's making up things about someone to get people to dislike them. Have you ever seen this happen in school or in the neighborhood? Take answers. How should you react? **When you hear** something bad about someone, a good first reaction is to doubt it, even if the person is adamantly saying the information is true. A second good reaction is to stand up for the victim. Say something nice about him or her. If that doesn't work, find an excuse to leave. DO NOT ADD to it.

3. To covet means to be jealous of. What is one way to know you are feeling jealous? You wish you had the item or situation too. Have you ever noticed that when someone gets a new item, wins an award, or gets some attention for a talent, that others have an inclination to be mean to that person rather than congratulate them? *That's jealousy.* What are some things we can do when we start feeling jealous, before it spirals into hateful comments or even bearing false witness? *One thing is to thank God for that person's good thing. Try to be happy for them. Don't assume they are using the situation to be powerful over others or are stuck up. Think of how YOU want to be treated when you come into something good.*

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TEACHER'S MIGHTY MESSAGE

Jesus said something incredible in the New Testament, 1,500 years after the Commandments arrived through Moses. He was answering someone who had asked, "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?"

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

He said, "ALL the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." God had created over 600 laws in the Old Testament. ALL are in some way tied into loving God or loving each other—not hurting each other, not being selfish, not causing heartbreak.

The Ten Commandments are designed to show people what love looks like and acts like. Jesus also said this, in John 13:35: By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another. People won't know us by our opinions. They won't know us by our clothes, bumper stickers, crosses, Bibles. Because those things don't affect others like our behavior does. The Ten Commandments are about loving God and loving each other here on earth. Let's try to learn them all, live by them all, and thereby spread God's love to those with whom we come into contact.






PRINTABLE CRAFT

SPINNING WHEEL

Here is a creative way to remind the children of God's holy Commandments.





MATERIALS:

- White paper or card stock
- Coloring utensils
- Scissors
- Brad fastener


INSTRUCTIONS:


- 1. Print out 10 Commandments Wheel templates on white paper or card stock.
- 2. Color as desired.
- 3. Cut out each of the templates and cut the "window" from the 10 Commandments Wheel cover.
- 4. Poke a small hole in the center of the marked circles on both the cover and wheel.
- 5. Push a brad fastener through each of the holes and pull the tines out to secure.













GAME

WHICH COMMANDMENTS ARE MISSING?

It's a simple way to help children learn the Commandments: Open a copy of them in Exodus 20 and have them put the cards in order. Exodus 20 is a bit thick in text, but they will garnish important ideas—directly from God's mouth!



MATERIALS:

- Ten Commandments for Kids file (follows these instructions)
- NIV Bible
- Paper
- Marker
- Scissors



PREPARATION:

1. Print out the Ten Commandments for Kids. Do not number them. Shuffle them.



- 1. Have students turn to Exodus 20 in the Bible.
- 2. Give them five minutes to put all the commandments in order, using only the Bible text as a guide.
- 3. Have them do again with the scripture available.
- 4. Then take the scripture away and have them try without it.






