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
## **LESSON OVERVIEW**

## "I AM" STATEMENTS OF CHRIST MIGHTY MESSAGE

This lesson on the I AM statements of Jesus will help children understand that Jesus was a lot more than a great prophet and kind healer. Jesus doesn't tell people that he knows the way to the door or that he can provide the bread of life. He said he IS those things. There are seven I AM statements Jesus made about himself, all in the Book of John. This lesson will help children see that no one could truthfully make such statements without being Lord of all.

#### How to Use the Lesson Kit:

This kit includes a variety of activities that you can select from to customize your perfect lesson. We suggest beginning with the Scripture Reading & Lesson followed by the Discussion Questions. From there, feel free to mix & match the activities to build your lesson plan based on the time you have alloted and the age level/interests of your kids.

## **SCRIPTURE & LESSON**

**EXCERPTS FROM THE GOSPEL OF JOHN (NIV)** 

Read the following excerpts as shown (NIV translation), or read from your chosen Bible translation:



#### THE SEVEN "I AM" STATEMENTS OF JESUS

**1**...I AM the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty. (John 6:35)

**2**. ...I AM the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life. (John 8:12)

**3**. ...I AM the gate. I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. (John 10:9)

**4.** ...I AM the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. (John 10:11)

**5**. ...I AM resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; (John 11:25)

**6.** ...I AM the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6)

7. ...I AM the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. 2 He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. (John 15:1-2)

#### **Questions for Children about the "I Am" Statements**

1. Jesus doesn't just say he HAS bread or he CAN SHOW THE WAY to the door. He says he IS these things. Why does he say it like that? *It sounds more important and is more important. Because he is our salvation, our savior. Our salvation is in a relationship with a real person, not with a list of rules.* 

2. In saying I AM THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD, Jesus is comparing himself to light. What is good about light? *It brings joy; it shows the way; it prevents us from stumbling around.* Have you ever had a problem resolve because of Jesus' teachings or his presence to guide your heart? If so, what happened?

3. Jesus says he is the GOOD SHEPHERD. Who are the sheep? *His followers.* What are some things a good shepherd would do? *Protect the sheep from wolves and other wild animals, feed them, give them water.* Have you ever felt Jesus was protecting you? What happened?

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#### **TEACHER'S MIGHTY MESSAGE**

Other religious leaders said, "I can open a door between you and God."

Jesus said, "I AM the door."

Other religious leaders said, "I can show you the way to God."

Jesus said, "I AM the way."

Other religious leaders said, "You all are like sheep. I can take you to a shepherd."

Jesus said, "I AM the good shepherd."

Jesus' claims about himself were bigger and bolder than any other religious leader's in history. He performed many miracles to prove he was telling the truth about his relationship with God the Father. Other religious leaders have told great stories about who they were, but guess what?

They couldn't back it up with a single miracle. Ever. In history. Ever.

You can visit the graves of most any religious leaders in recent history. Religious leaders who lived a long time ago, their graves are often lost. But what's the difference between them all and Jesus? Jesus came back from the dead.

Jesus came back, and he was seen by over 500 people between his death in Jerusalem and his ascension 40 days later. Today, he lives in heaven.

When we try Christianity, we find we do not have a religion based on following rules. We don't have one based on strange imaginings. We have a religion based on a person, one who loves us and wants to fellowship with us. That's what the seven I AM statements of Jesus are all about.

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## PRINTABLE FLIPBOOK



Print these pages onto white cardstock or paper.





Cut into individual pages. You will have 1 cover page, and 7 "I am" statement pages.





Punch holes where indicated, put in order, and connect with a book ring or string.



#### **Suggested Uses:**

1) Create the flip books as a craft during your lesson. Have the kids cut out each page, punch holes, and tie up their mini-book as a study guide to use throughout the week.

2) Encourage kids to explain the statement of Christ in their own words on the back of each page.

3) Challenge the kids to study the flip book by a certain date and then have a contest to see who has memorized all seven statements!



# GAME

## I AM STATEMENTS MATCHING GAME

Each I AM statement contains two parts: The I AM statement and an explanatory statement. The explanatory statement helps make the I AM statement more clear.

# **OBJECTIVE**

Be the first team to guess correctly which explanatory statements go with the appropriate I AM statements.



## MATERIALS:

Game cards (follows the instructions)

## **PREPARATION**

Print out enough copies so that you have one for each pair of students



# **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Divide class into pairs.

2. Give each pair a set of the 14 printout cards, shuffled

3.Explain that the cards contain the seven I AM statements of Christ. There are 14 cards because each I AM statement has a beginning part, which is the I AM statement itself, and each has an explanatory part, which helps shed more light on the I AM statement.

4.First, ask them to find the seven I AM statements and lay them out in front of themselves and their teammate.


5. Second, ask them to use logic to decide which ending goes with which beginning.



## PARENT HANDOUT

#### This Week We Learned About ...

...the I AM statements of Jesus. The lesson helped children understand that Jesus was a lot more than a great prophet and kind healer. Jesus doesn't tell people that he knows the way to the door or that he can provide the bread of life. He said he IS those things. There are seven I AM statements Jesus made about himself, all in the Book of John. This lesson will help children see that no one could truthfully make such statements without being Lord of all.

#### Questions for Kids:

- 1. Jesus refers to himself as the what of the world? *A. Light*
- 2. Jesus is the vine and the father is what? *A. The gardener*
- 3.Jesus also calls himself the good \_\_\_\_\_. *A. Shepherd*

#### Dinner Table Discussion:

Jesus says that he is that vine, we are the branches, and the Father is the gardener. What in our lives makes us branches that bear fruit? Can you describe the fruit in your life? Can you describe an area where you would like to grow or bear more fruit?

What do you think Jesus means when he says he is the bread of life and "whoever comes to me will not be hungry?" How do you feel "fed" in your spiritual life? In what ways do you feel lacking, if any, and in what ways do you feel you have everything you need?

#### **REFERENCE SHEET**

•	All the I AM Statements of Jesus are from the <b>Book of John.</b>
•	<b>They do not all occur in the same place,</b> like the Beatitudes (Jesus' eight BLESSED ARE Statements from Matthew 5).
•	The I AM Statements are in almost every other chapter of John, starting with <b>Chapter Six, then</b> <b>Eight, Ten (contains two), Eleven, and Fourteen.</b> So, think of them as being in every other <b>chapter between Six and Fourteen, Eleven being the oddball, and Ten containing a double.</b>
•	They are spread throughout John's book because they were <b>spread throughout Jesus' ministry.</b> It was important to them that people understand who Jesus was, what his placement was in God's eyes, and what he could do for us. It was a big part of Jesus' ministry.




