- If you could be a missionary anywhere in the world, where would you choose? Why?

KidConvos can definitely start people talking, and the scripture verses are inspiring! All scriptures are presented in either the New International Version or the King James Version of our Bible, based on your choice!

KidConvos can be used at the table after dinner or during long car rides. They can be used at the end of a Sunday school class or in place of a game. They can be used at sleepovers or around the fire on camping trips. Wherever you want the conversation to be edifying, growth-oriented, thoughtful, and fun — bring out the cards and have someone pull the first one.
