SCRIPTURE & LESSON

PASSAGE (NIV): SCRIPTURES THAT FOCUS ON GRATITUDE

Read the following excerpts as shown (NIV translation), or read from your chosen Bible translation:



Psalm 100:1-5

Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth.

- Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs.
- ³ Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.
- ⁴ Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.
- ⁵ For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

Romans 5:6-8

⁶You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.

⁷ Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die.

⁸ But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Questions for Children about Thanksgiving

- 1. Name some things for which you are grateful to God—little or big things in your life. **You should get plenty of answers.**
- 2. The second verse doesn't tell us to be thankful. It gives us something to be thankful about. What was the "big thing" that Jesus did? *He died as a sacrifice for the sins of others.*
- 3. Oftentimes we only speak to God when we want something. Why do you think it is so much easier to see what we **want** rather than what we already **have**? This may be a good time to bring up school, and how being in large crowds, such as a classroom, creates a chronic comparison for some people: Shorter than me; bigger than me; richer than me; more friends than me; better clothes than me. By making students aware, you can discuss how to break out of that.



TEACHER'S MIGHTY MESSAGE

Thanksgiving is a time to be joyful and thankful. Of course, we want to thank God for our toys, pets, parents, and food. But sometimes we miss the bigger things he has done.

The verse in Romans 5 says that sometimes a heroic person would offer to die in the place of a very righteous man. Jesus died for normal people like us-- as a sacrifice for our wrongdoings. He did it so we can all have a relationship with God, starting now. The Apostle Paul said in 1 Corinthians 13:12, "Now we see only a reflection in a mirror." It will become clearer after we go up to heaven, and it will last forever.

Think of it like someone running in front of a train to remove a small child who is sitting there. He person tosses the child to safety but gets hit himself. There are normal people who would do such a thing. A parent would do it for their own child, whom they love more than anyone. A grandparent or an aunt or uncle might do so also.

The thing is, that Jesus did this for people he didn't even hang around with. He did it for people who wouldn't even be born for another 2,000 years. He did it for the very people who were mean to him while he was dying on the cross. He did it for us.

The love of Christ is unmatched in human history. God and Jesus provide us with love, guidance, protection, direction, immortality, peace, and security. Let's remember, on Thanksgiving, to thank him for the big things.

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PRINTABLE CRAFT



MATERIALS:

- White paper or cardstock
- Fall colored paper or cardstock
- Coloring utensils
- Marker or pen
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Print out the Thanking Tree Template on white paper, and the Leaves Template on fall colored paper or card stock.
- 2. Color the Thanking Tree as desired.
- 3. Cut out the leaves.
- 4. With a marker or pen, write on the leaves different things that you are thankful to God for.
- 5. Glue the leaves to the Thanking Tree.
- 6. Hang up to display an adorable reminder of gratitude!
















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THANKING TREE





GAME

THANKS FOR... OH YEAH!

This game will require some concentration and a paper and pencil. It will hone their gratitude skills like nothing played before!



MATERIALS:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Simple item like a piece of fruit or a spool of thread or a bag of Legos.



PREPARATION:

None

Objective:

Be the first to have 15 reasons to be grateful for the item written down.



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Place the item in the middle of the learning table after giving out the pencils and paper.
- 2. Tell students to write down everything reason they can think of to be thankful for that item.
- 3. Tell them to try to reach 15 reasons.
- 4. After several minutes, have them each read their reasons. Applaud the original ones especially. Have them scratch off any that are just silly or don't make sense.
- 5. Tell them to write down each other's reasons, adding them to their own list.6. The first student to reach 15 reasons for gratitude wins.

Conclusion:

We often get great gifts from God. And we either don't recognize them or we forget to say "thank you!" If we spent a little time each day of the year, focusing in on one object and figuring out how it has blessed us, how much more grateful would we be?

Let's remember not just to be thankful for the very serious or very obvious things; let's look at gratitude as an opportunity to explore all the little pieces of the world God gave us.

PSALM 35:18	I will give you thanks in the great assembly; among the throngs I will praise you.
PSALM 69:30	I will praise God's name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving.
PSALM 100:4	Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.
PSALM 106:1	Praise the Lord. Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever.
PSALM 107:8	Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind.
PSALM 118:21	I will give you thanks, for you answered me; you have become my salvation.




